

WE ALL KNOW PLACES THAT AROUSE OUR CURIOSITY SINCE CHILDHOOD AND THAT CONTINUE TO FASCINATE US MANY YEARS LATER. TODAY, AS AN ADULT, I AM GETTING READY TO GO BACK TO THE WEST OF THE VOSGES AND REDISCOVER THIS AREA, WHERE THE DETAILS ARE THE KEY TO HISTORY. FROM GALLO-ROMAN RUINS TO ARCHITECTURAL TREASURES, EACH STONE IS THE SYMBOL OF UNEXPECTED VESTIGES, WITNESSES TO THE EXCEPTIONAL DESTINIES THAT HAVE BEEN FORGED HERE. LET ME TAKE YOU ON A JOURNEY THROUGH THE AGES, A REAL TREASURE HUNT IN SEARCH OF THE SECRETS CLOSELY KEPT BY TIME.



ENJOY EXPERIENCES FROM ACROSS THE CENTURIES

FULLY EXPERIENCE ANTIQUITY IN GRAND

I begin my journey across the ages in the heart of the Gallo-Roman era, in the city of Andesina (or should I say 'Grand', as the city is called today).

Grand is a small, peaceful village that hides many secrets, as it contains the spectacular remains of an ancient city that was home to over 10,000 inhabitants. Each visit is a guaranteed amazement, especially when you realise that the archaeological excavations have not yet revealed all the secrets and that many mysteries remain unexplored.

One of the must-sees is indisputably the mosaic, a masterpiece of over 232 m² in size that makes me feel tiny. When you look at it, you really feel like you are living in that era. Basilica, court or reception room? It is hard to know precisely what these thousands of tesserae saw. But the grandeur of this place is an invitation to visualise the life of the past. Not far away, the amphitheatre site is obviously worth a visit.

'Wow!' - this is usually what people say when they see this huge vestige.

And with a length of 148 metres, it is one of the largest in the Roman Empire. By visiting it, you enter a parallel universe. There, you can still hear the gladiatorial combats resonating under the vaults, and the shouts and applause of over 17,000 spectators.

Looking at the museum's showcases, my attention is drawn to a pair of loaded dice found during excavations. Were the Romans cheaters? Well, maybe they were!

I could have stayed a bit longer to explore Grand in more depth, with its archaeological garden and its 2.5km path through the village. But I have another opportunity just a few kilometres away: to meet a legendary figure, Joan of Arc.



THE WHISPERS OF ART

600 years ago, a young shepherdess later known as Joan of Arc heard the voice of God for the first time in a small village in the Vosges mountains. Guided by these divine words, she would later lead the French armies to decisive victories against the English troops during the Hundred Years' War, leaving her mark on the history of France

This is where I am taking you, to Domrémyla-Pucelle, where the Basilica of Saint Joan of Arc stands. Built in her honour in 1881 in her native village, it is located near the place where she is said to have heard divine voices.

I arrive at midday, time for the angelus, and I am welcomed by the melody of the bells. The view from the top of this little slope is quite nice: the plain stretches away and a part of the Meuse region meanders through the fields. The outside of the Basilica is sumptuous, but I really recommend you to visit the inside, with

its eight huge paintings that retrace the life of the Saint, from her childhood to her tragic death at the stake.

A guide is leading a tour for a small group and I strain my ears to catch a few anecdotes. I promise myself to go to the Tourist Office to come back and discover her birthplace and the 'Visages de Jehanne' centre in the heart of the village. But before that, I must eat something because my stomach is rumbling.

GOURMET BREAK

For a short break with a wonderful view, the picnic tables are the perfect spot for a sandwich. If you are a gourmet, there is something for everyone at the restaurant Le Bois Chenu, right next to the Basilica, where I am always delighted to come back. The atmosphere is bucolic, and the food is delicious. The menu is mouthwatering and I have trouble choosing, so I decide to chat with Chef Vincent. With his warm smile and his enthusiasm, he talks to me about his dishes, we discuss the local

products, his way of revisiting the recipes and, to be honest, I am getting hungry just listening to him!



He also communicates his passion on video, and you can find out more about his culinary secrets here.

IT'S TIME TO DISCOVER OTHER PERIODS

And speaking of voices and intuitions, mine told me that Neufchâteau deserved much more than just a simple visit.

Although I often do some shopping there, this time, my desire to explore led me to the Tourist Office, where I had booked a VIP visit. Let's go for two hours of exploration with Nicolas, a passionate and enthusiast who lives in Neufchâteau. With period photos, he takes me through the streets, recalling the great hours and the forgotten details.

Even a few words will not do justice to this trip. Neufchâteau cannot be explained, it has to be experienced. Its jewels are

hidden, and only the curious minds will be able to discover their secrets. From surprise to surprise, from monument to monument, the tour promises to transport you through the eras with fascinating stories, which I'll keep in mind to avoid spoiling the surprise for those who want to try the adventure.

Despite this, I am keen to share with you my favourite discovery. The old Dames Augustines convent, with its modest façade, is home to an Italian-style theatre dating from the early 19th century. It is fascinating to imagine that this site has witnessed the fashion and costumes of the past two centuries, with generations of spectators coming to be entertained in this magnificent setting, with a painted roof that will amaze you.

The rest of the tour has plenty of other heritage wonders to reveal – and believe me, you are missing out if you spend any time in the West of Vosges without visiting this town. On the programme: hidden rooms

under the church of Saint-Nicolas, an original chapel in the church of Saint-Christophe, a former court with its furniture registered as a Historic Monument, and to top it all, the Houdreville Hotel with its remarkable architecture.

My day is coming to an end and I am going home with a feeling of having travelled through the centuries. All I can suggest is that you let yourself be surprised by the hidden treasures of the West of this region, by following in the footsteps of those who lived, dreamed, fought, and left deep marks in stone and landscape.

Tomorrow, we will change scenery. I will take you on a relaxing spa experience, a guaranteed escape.




RELAX, TAKE IT EASY

THERMAL SPRINGS OF THE REGION

Today I'm going to Contrexéville for a day of relaxation. My plan is to meet up with a friend for a delicious breakfast at the 'Les Goûts Thés des Thermes' tea room before enjoying a wellness break at the Thermal Spa. As I am a little early, I can take a stroll in the park and admire the thermal gallery. There are two outstanding buildings, an Orthodox chapel and a Protestant temple, which will delight visitors who are interested in history. My steps lead me to the Pavillon des Sources; it's impossible to miss it, as the rotunda dominates the centre of the gallery. Curious, I open the door to take a look. Under its high dome-

shaped roof, the large bay windows let in natural light and highlight the statue of the Verseuses.

And, speaking of springs, I learned that the Thermal Gallery is home to three springs: the Contrex® spring in the pavilion (which is bottled), the Souveraine spring, located at the other end of the gallery, and the Châtillon-Lorraine spring, accessible only in the Thermal baths. Each spring is unique, with its own different mineral content, rich in calcium and magnesium. The local inhabitants know all about this, and regularly come here to fill their bottles.



TIME FOR A THERMAL BATH

I have found the perfect way to relax, and as I am nice, I am sharing it with you: the 'Parenthèse Bien-Être' formula, offered by the Tourist Office. The package comprises access to the thermal baths and lunch in the partner restaurant of my choice. What an ideal combination for a reasonably-priced day of relaxation.

The thermal baths are open to spa clients all year round, coming to enjoy the benefits of thermal water to help treat various illnesses, but the spa area is open to everyone from 6 years old. So, we put on our best outfit (sandals and swimming costume/trunks) and we are ready to discover this little corner of paradise. Two hours for us to fully enjoy.

We start on the ground floor, in the huge pool of around 300m2 fitted with massage jets, aquabikes, treadmills and elliptical bikes, where it is also possible to book a water sports session. Next, I head to the first floor, where I experience a sensory cabin: aromatherapy, relaxing music and

subdued lighting; I almost fell asleep. On the top floor, there are steam rooms, saunas and solariums. If you are feeling daring, try the ice bucket for a shock of freshness. I tried the whole experience and wow! It woke me up! The best part, in my opinion, are the outdoor Jacuzzi baths. Located on a terrace, they offer a breathtaking view of the surrounding area. While I splash about, my friend prefers the sunbathing option on a deckchair.

Don't leave the thermal centre without taking the time to taste the water! You can access the Châtillon-Lorraine spring via several self-service fountains located throughout the complex.

You can either bring your own cup, or purchase one at the reception for €1, perfect for a little souvenir.

And to make this relaxing session complete, you can also let yourself be

seduced by the numerous sports, leisure and stress management activities organised each week by the Tourist Office.





FOOD IS READY!

After this extraordinary experience, let's return to reality, and why not take a lunch break to prolong this moment of pleasure? Let's try Les Commis, a restaurant located just 60 metres from the Thermal Baths. As soon as I push open the door, I am greeted by the delicious aromas. Here, everything is open: the kitchen and restaurant are a single space, and the chef arranges his plates right before our eyes. The menu is simple but focuses on local produce, a true promise of quality. From starts to desserts, you will savour sincere cuisine, as we like it. We advise you to book in advance! Locals and visitors really love this address, and soon you will understand why.







PLACE YOUR BETS

Our fun journey continues with an entertaining stopover at the Casino. I feel like a celebrity as I climb the red-carpeted steps. The setting is amazing, with the gaming room set in an old Italian-style theatre. Two different worlds meet to offer you a very special experience. Even if you are not a slot machine lover, this place is worth a visit. For heritage enthusiasts, there is a booklet explaining the history of the building available at the entrance, so you can discover it without entering the gaming room. Personally, I can't resist the temptation. But we have to be reasonable, the day is not over and there is just one last thing we have to do at all costs.

AN ESCAPE TO THE WATER'S EDGE

No need to go very far to end this beautiful day with a breath of fresh air. We decide to walk around the Lacs des Folie. This green area is a little paradise where you can enjoy a wide range of leisure activities during the summer months, a popular spot for families, fishermen, groups of friends and nature enthusiasts. But today is my lazy day, and as I already had my trunks on, we opt for the free outdoor pool instead of the pedalo. The perfect way to finish off this relaxing break is by reading a good book and sunbathing on a towel on the grass.

In Contrexéville, relax, breath and enjoy. We leave this sweet escape feeling refreshed in body and mind, and ready to explore new horizons. And precisely six kilometres away, another thermal town is waiting for us: Vittel.

Tomorrow, I will show you this town from a completely different angle. See you there!



THE OPPORTUNITY TO EXPERIENCE THE UNEXPECTED

THE PLACE FOR GOOD IDEAS

To begin my journey in Vittel, I start by visiting the Tourist Office, situated in the station building. If you love beautiful stone architecture, this registered monument is worth a visit, with its superb cupola and period furniture! I arrive with a vague idea of the activities I want to do during the day, but

they make some interesting recommendations at the ticket office and help me to fill my day. Let's go! I booked all my day's activities on site, satisfied that I wouldn't miss anything fundamental.



LIKE AN AIR OF CENTRAL PARK

In just five minutes on foot, I am at the park entrance. Wow, what a setting! I feel like I am in a 19th-century bourgeois private garden, except that here, everyone is welcome. At the heart of the park, with its 30 heritage buildings, the Thermal Gallery is full of life, with its period style, shops and Hépar pavilion. You can also drink water directly from the fountain. If you are an athlete, a dreamer, an explorer or a bon vivant, the park is full of activities that will satisfy all your desires. During my walk, I take a number of very Instagrammable photos. And I'm sure you will do the same!

If you love unusual spots, I recommend you to make a first stop at the 'Exèdre à musique', a rather original piece of architecture, surrounded by flowers, where there are sometimes concerts. Then, be sure to have a look at the old bottling plant, called the Palmarium. With its art deco design and heritage classification, it proves that even industry had to look good to maintain the harmony of the place. Today, this iconic building is about to write a new chapter, because yes, the thermal baths are going to be transformed to be even more attractive.

PONY TREK

Exploring the park's 650 hectares on foot can quickly become a real expedition. So I opt for a different option and go to the equestrian centre nearby for a horse ride. Before going for a ride, the instructor helps me to get fitted and prepare my horse: adjust the saddle, put the bit in its mouth, brush it, and so on. "A horse is not a bike", she jokes. Let's go! I begin slowly inside the school in order to feel confident, and then go for a 1-hour ride through the wooded paths. Even a novice like me can feel safe and reassured. And this connection with the animal - it really changes everything.

LUNCH WITH A SPECIAL VIEW

For lunch break, I'm not going very far, as I have booked a table at the Rotonde Restaurant in the heart of the park, in front of the gallery. Seated on the terrace, with a little jazz music in the background and a spectacular view, I treat myself to a

bistronomic menu. Between the setting and the food, it is difficult to know exactly what I like best!

For dessert, I dash off to the little pavilion that I had spotted earlier on entering the park, one of the picturesque little kiosks that decorate the place. Impossible to resist, I decide to eat an ice cream to make the most of this enchanting setting.

TROTTING TO THE RACECOURSE

If you visit Vittel on a summer weekend, the horse races are not to be missed. And no, they are not just for the elite, as you would think: for €5, you can access the racecourse, just a 10-minute walk from the thermal baths. The century-old buildings with their retro atmosphere and the vibration of the horses' hooves at full gallop take me back in time. The annual hat competition on 15th August is particularly memorable, a real nod to the glamour of yesteryear. From the moment you arrive, the excitement is intense: around the parade ring, the punters examine the horses to choose their favourite. I try my luck and, as soon as the bet is placed, the stakes become very different: when my horse starts running,



I feel as if it is running just for me. Even if, like me, you know absolutely nothing about racing, I promise you that the experience is well worth a try. There are a variety of activities available, depending on the theme, and you can even eat on site. Enough to occupy young and old for the whole day.

RIGHT IN THE BULL'S-EYE

I promised you something out of the ordinary, well this last activity is no exception. I take the wheel again and drive to the forest a little further up, for the clay-pigeon shooting! You may have heard of it before, commonly referred to as 'pigeon shooting', but don't worry, this experience has never harmed any animals - they are in reality clay trays.

I am welcomed in a traditional chalet with a warm, rustic atmosphere. René and his wife, owners of the place for several years, greet me with a smile. Equipped with ear

defenders and a rifle, René explains to me the safety rules and shows me the correct posture. We set up outside, and I finally understand the expression

'Take aim!': you have to press your cheek against the butt, properly aligned with the rifle. 'PULL!' a clay tray is tossed into the air. I aim... BANG! Missed, wide... Beginner's luck is not for me. But I get caught up in the game, one shot after another, and I finally hit one of the trays. At least I'm not going home a loser!

Once again, the Vosges Plain reveals unexpected treasures. In Vittel, everything is naturally connected: Heritage, nature and activities combine to create a journey that is as coherent as it is original. One thing is for sure: Here, we get off the beaten track and want to relive the experience.





EXPLORE THE TALENTS OF YESTERDAY AND TODAY

THE HANDS THAT GIVE VOICE TO THE WOOD

People often say that the violin is an extension of the human voice, of the soul and the passions that drive it. In Mirecourt, this idea is more evident than ever. My adventure started with an appointment with a violin maker to observe this fascinating expertise with my own eyes. This meeting was organised by the Tourist Office. Every Monday in summer, luthiers welcome the public to their workshops, by prior arrangement. Apart from this period, it is possible to obtain a list of contacts to plan a visit directly with the craftsmen. The museum also offers tours of the old 'Chez Gérôme' workshop, where Georges Brassens' guitars were made. A beautiful journey back in time!

Greeted by the violin maker with a smile, I enter a fascinating place, with its unique smell of wood and varnish, an authentic blend found nowhere else. The workshop is a real eye-catcher, with violins and violas hanging in rows, their amber hues glowing in the light, and large double basses standing on the floor. A lot of questions come to my mind, and he answers me with passion. Techniques, anecdotes, know-how transmission... I leave with just one word in my head: admiration.



To immerse yourself in the atmosphere, let yourself be hypnotised by the woodwork with this video of how a violin is made.



WHEN THE MUSIC RINGS

I decide to continue my musical discovery by visiting the House of Mechanical Music museum. Let's go for an immersion in the world of serinettes, barrel organs and other instruments of the fairs and exhibitions of yesteryear. This time, there is no self-guided visit, and so much the better, as the communicative energy of Julie, a passionate guide for over 20 years, makes the visit even more captivating. What a trip! It is not just about looking at the collection, it is also about taking part in the entertainment. Turning the crank, you can listen to the melodies of yesteryear, and I dare you to remain impassive: even the most timid of visitors begin to beat time with their feet on the floor. I was carried away by the atmosphere and I dared to do some dance steps. Friendly atmosphere guaranteed!

As a bonus, the museum also contains some bobbin lace, another of Mirecourt's specialities. To buy some, you will have to go to the Tourist Office just opposite, the only place to find these handmade

treasures. They are displayed together with a range of local handmade crafts, and in particular pieces of wickerwork, another talent from Mirecourt. The perfect gift for friends and family, or just to treat yourself!

LUNCH ON THE GRASS

For lunch break, I stop at the Nollot bakery to buy a sandwich, then head to the banks of the Madon, a real corner of paradise in the very centre of Mirecourt. A wooden table awaits me under a big tree, right next to the river, which laps softly. The setting is perfect. The green grass, the sound of water... A simple moment, but so pleasant.

MUSIC AS A HERITAGE

My immersion in the world of violin making is not yet over. After eating, I head for the Tourist Office, where they offer me a self-guided discovery tour. This tour is an invitation to a special kind of walk: the luthiers' trail (Sentier des luthiers),

a treasure hunt that leads me in the footsteps of craftsmen of the past.

With a questionnaire in hand, I will explore the historic sites related to the trades of violin and bow makers in Mirecourt. As the visit progresses, I become aware of the scope of this activity, which has left its mark on the town. They talk about tradition, tools and materials. Do you know what Pernambouc is? Visit the Mirecourt Museum to find out! There is one last mission at the entrance: a padlock with code is waiting for me, and the clues found along the way are the key to open it. Of course, I'm not about to tell you everything, but the treasure to be found inside is definitely a must-see, and a perfect souvenir.

I am not really sure what to expect when I enter the Museum, but everything is designed to make this world, often perceived as elitist, more accessible, without losing its magic. It houses an incredible collection of objects and instruments that tell the story of centuries of craftsmanship. The real advantage is





the space where you can handle, test and experiment. I tried a bow on a viola to experience the vibrations. It's crazy, you feel immediately connected to the instrument. With the help of a booklet and various listening posts, I wandered at my own pace, discovering the history of violin making in Mirecourt. In short: captivating and fun, impossible not to get carried away!

A VINTAGE JOURNEY

On the way back, I make a stop at the Ville-sur-Illon brewery, which features a museum dedicated to beer-making in the early 20th century. Let's go back in time with a demonstration led by passionate volunteers who revive the skills of yesteryear. Before visiting the shop for a tasting of local beer, I take a look at the period advertising objects displayed. A great way to finish the day - but in moderation!

What a day! Mirecourt and its surrounding area is a melting pot of culture, emotions and authentic encounters. Here, everything oozes music and know-how. To be honest, it makes you want to come, doesn't it? If you want to experience something different, this is the perfect place to come. My trip to discover the treasures of the Vosges Plain is coming to an end, and who knows, maybe, like me, you will come back home with the feeling of having explored a place like no other. Now, it's your turn!


